Christian Moral Development

- Learn how to take on the attitude of Christ
- Learn how Church teaching informs moral decisionmaking

- Apply the decision-making model of see, judge, act, evaluate in order to determine the loving thing to do
- Understand the nature of sin (personal and social)
- Identify social justice issues (e.g. poverty, labour practices, ecology, etc.) and how to justly respond to them

Prayer and Sacramental Life

- Understand the importance of prayer in one's life for building our relationship with God/Jesus and others
- Learn, describe and use the various forms of prayer
- Understand God's role and ours in prayer

Family Life

- Explore and express some of the qualities of relationships one can have
- Respect the unique intellect of each person
- Understand the role of emotions in one's life
- Value the sacredness of human life
- Understand the Christian dimension of love and how we are to live it out
- Recognize the signs of healthy and unhealthy relationships
- Analyze sexual issues (e.g. STIs, HIV/AIDS, same-sex orientation) in relation to the virtue of chastity
- Identify duties, roles and responsibilities within Christian families
